



Credit Transfer/Advanced Standing for International Students

As part of your admission you may be given course **credit transfer** or advanced standing for previous study. Under UNSW3+ from 2019 and onwards, any credit transfer or advanced standing can potentially affect your program completion date.

If the course credit is given **before** your visa is granted, your **Confirmation of Enrolment** end date will reflect this and the length of your program will be reduced accordingly.

If course credit is given **after** your visa is issued, and results in your program length being shorter, the University must report the change of program length to the **Immigration Department** which will affect your visa expiration date.

You are required to maintain a full-time study load, even if you have been given course credit.

The University will only report changes to your program duration to the **Immigration Department** if your degree is shortened due to Credit Transfer or Advanced Standing. You will receive a revised CoE that reflect the length of your program.
