Volunteer tasks differ between each position:

- Student@UNSW - This group assists in UNSW-run events, for example orientation week, events, video promotions, Information Day, focus groups on a casual basis when you have time.
- Opinion Leaders - As part of a team you will be interacting with other students on a weekly basis, having the opportunity to share knowledge and experiences with people from a diverse background.
- Accessibility Ambassador – The accessibility ambassadors are student volunteers that help keep the campus inclusive and assist everyone on campus to experience and being able to fully participate in the events.
